PROGRAMME MODE

The programme will be offered in both Full-Time and Part-Time Mode.

The classes for Full Time programme will be held on all working days as per University working hours.

The Part Time programme is meant for the working teachers and academic administrators. The classes will be held in the afternoon/evening or on the weekends.

The courses offered for both will be same as given in the table above.

DURATION

For the full time programme, the duration of each semester will be of about 14-15 weeks excluding teaching practice and examinations. For the part time programme each semester will be of 20-22 weeks excluding examinations and the classes will be held for about 15 hours per week.

TEACHING PRACTICE

The teaching practice is mandatory for all the participants and carries weightage in the evaluation of their performance. For the full time programme, the teaching practice will be held along with the course work. The working teachers will record their experiences in the Teaching Practice File and will be evaluated at the end of each semester. For full time programme, the teaching practice will be of 10 weeks (regular) out of which 4 weeks will be in November-December and 6 weeks in April-May to coincide with the school calendar. The learnings will be evaluated based on the Teaching Practice File to be maintained by the participants and the seminar/ viva at the end of the semester/ practice. A report will also be obtained from the school where the participant will undergo teaching practice.

WORK LOAD

The teaching - learning will be based on lectures as well as practical/ workshop sessions. The total contact hours for both the semesters will be about 600 irrespective of it being full time or part time programme. It is mandated that the Participant will be required to put in about 1200 hours of self-study or work outside the classroom.
